WFD CIRCABC - the Information Exchange Platform


One of the key activities under the joint implementation of the Water Framework Directive (WFD) is the improvement of the information exchange between Countries, European institutions, the various stakeholders and the interested public. In order to promote greater information exchange and to facilitate the work in the numerous expert groups, the Commission set up an internet-based platform called "CIRCA" which has since migrated to a new platform called "CIRCABC".

CIRCABC stands for "**C**ommunication and **I**nformation **R**esource **C**entre for **A**ministrations, **B**usinesses and **C**itizens" and it is a web-based service provided by the European Commission. It is used to create collaborative workspaces where communities of users can work together and share information and resources. CIRCABC is financed by the **ISA**. The Directorate General for Informatics at the European Commission (DG DIGIT) is responsible for coordinating the development and the user community. It hosts the application and provides helpdesk and support.

The CIRCABC platform is used to share documents (including meeting documents) under the WFD Common Implementation Strategy (CIS) and can be accessed [here](#).


